BUSKING PERMIT GUIDELINES

Busking is defined as playing a musical instrument and/or singing, conjuring, juggling, mime, dance, puppetry, performance art, recitation and other appropriate theatrical and visual form.

All performers must be within acceptable volume levels, so as not to inconvenience the public or the operation of Riverway.

Buskers must not use battery or mains voltage amplification.

Buskers must ensure that the area within which they are performing (including the area used by any audience) does not pose a threat to public safety.

An authorised Officer of Council may at any time instruct a Busker to immediately terminate their performance if the Officer deems it to be too loud, offensive, dangerous or harmful to private or public property or the busker is without a permit.

The permit holder must not interfere in any way with an approved entertainment or activity.

The Permit Holder will be allocated an area of the Market in which to perform and the busker must remain in that allocated area whilst performing. Performers must have a 10 minute break every 20 minutes.

Permits will be issued for no more than 4 weeks in advance.

Persons performing on behalf of political or religious organisation shall not hold permits.

It is not permitted to have any equipment which display "Trade logos" (eg Ford, Holden, Coca Cola, etc), without prior approval by the Market Coordinator.

The Riverway Night Markets commence at 5.30pm and conclude at 9.30pm.

Insurance

It is not a mandatory condition that buskers hold and maintain a public liability insurance policy, however, in certain circumstances the absence of appropriate coverage may leave a busker open to personal liability in the event that a negligent act leads to a third party

injury or loss.

Council's public liability insurance policy does not cover a Busker's liability exposures. It is requested that a Risk Assessment Form be completed and sent to council along with your Application.
